Player Code of Conduct

This code of conduct outlines the expected behaviours and conduct of all players at Warwick Greenwood Junior Cricket Club

All players are expected to:

- Uphold the values and ethos of WGJCC Club
- Demonstrate the spirit of cricket in all that they do and say on and off the field
- Wear full Club uniform to training sessions and games (no District uniforms)
- Adhere to protective equipment rules at all training sessions and games
- Abide by the umpire's decisions at all times, leave the field immediately if dismissed, do not argue or excessively discuss decisions
- Always display appropriate behaviour, no excessive appealing, throwing equipment, no physical or verbal threats, no physical contact or assault
- Speak respectfully to all players, officials, umpires and spectators regardless of gender, ability or cultural background – no arguing, sledging or use of obscene, offensive or insulting language
- Keep to time – no deliberate tactics to slow the game for advantage
- Play by the rules – do not attempt to manipulate the outcome of a game or change the condition of a ball or any other equipment
- Report any issues with opponents/spectators to their coach or manager during breaks
- Use social media appropriately, no sledging of players, coaches or managers in group chats or social posts, no making and sharing of videos

Any breaches to this code of conduct will be penalised using the CJCC Offence and penalty guidelines and WGJCC policies

Players may be:

- Suspended from playing cricket
- Removed from captaincy
- Disqualified from Club awards
- Suspended/banned from attending Club events
- Reported to WA Cricket and have offences recorded in Play HQ
- In extreme situations, charged according to WA Laws
