Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

This code of conduct outlines the expected behaviours and conduct of all parents and guardians of Warwick Greenwood Junior Cricket Club Junior players.

All parents/guardian are expected to:

- Uphold the values and ethos of WGJCC Club
- Model the spirit of cricket for your children by appreciating and acknowledging good play from all participants (not just your child's team)
- Remind players to play by the rules and show respect to officials and umpires and their decisions – do not contradict decisions
- Adhere to protective equipment rules at all training sessions and games
- Always display appropriate behaviour, – no arguing, sledging or use of obscene, offensive or insulting language, no physical or verbal threats, no physical contact or assaults towards any players, coaches, managers, umpires, officials or other spectators or parents.
- Speak respectfully to all players, officials, umpires and spectators
- Support the coach by NOT calling out instructions to players on the field/giving playing advice to players
- Show appreciation for volunteer coaches, managers, officials and administrators. Without them, your child could not participate.
- abide by Club/Association/Council Healthy Club Policies at matches – no smoking, vaping or alcohol
- Never approach or interact verbally with opposition players, coaches, managers or umpires. Always speak to your team's coach or manager.
- Model appropriate use of social media, no sledging of players, coaches or managers in group chats or social posts

Any breaches to this code of conduct will be penalised according to WGJCC/CJCC policies

Parents/guardians may be

- Suspended/banned from attending matches and/or Club events
- Reported to WA Cricket and have offences recorded in Play HQ
- In extreme situations, charged according to WA Laws
