Coach and Manager Code of Conduct

This code of conduct outlines the expected behaviours and conduct of all coaches and managers at Warwick Greenwood Junior Cricket Club

All coaches and managers are expected to:

- Uphold the values and ethos and policies and procedures of WGJCC Club and not bring the Club into disrepute
- Model the spirit of cricket and good sportsmanship and teach your players to do the same
- Remind players to play by the rules and show respect to officials and umpires and their decisions by not arguing or contradicting decisions
- Give all players, regardless of ability, equal time, attention and participation and be transparent with your rotation procedures
- Always display appropriate behaviour, – no arguing, sledging or use of obscene, offensive or insulting language, no physical or verbal threats, no physical contact or assaults towards any players, coaches, managers, umpires, officials, spectators or parents.
- Speak respectfully to all players, officials, umpires, parents and spectators regardless of ability, gender, cultural background
- Provide coaching and instruction during the game as appropriate to the age level of players
- Not to reprimand players on other teams, all concerns must be conveyed through opposition coach/manager
- Know the rules for your age group, the CJCC General Rules and the Laws of Cricket
- Abide by Club/Association/Council Healthy Club Policies at matches – no smoking, vaping or alcohol
- Wear game day long sleeved shirt and wide brim hat to promote sun safety
- Only have physical contact with players appropriate to the situation and necessary for the player's skill development.
- Ensure that equipment and facilities meet safety standards and are appropriate to the age and ability of all players.

Any breaches to this code of conduct will be penalised according to WGJCC policies

Coaches and managers may be:

- Suspended from coaching/managing
- Required to step down as coach or manager
- Suspended/banned from attending Club events
- Reported to WA Cricket and have offences recorded in Play HQ
- Suspended from playing in Senior grades and/or in other Associations
- In extreme situations, charged according to WA Laws
